

## Foreign National Community Recommendation Application Checklist

- Confirm you meet IRCC [eligibility requirements](#) to apply for the Rural and Northern Immigration Pilot
- Create a Candidate profile at [www.economicdevelopmentbrandon.com/BrandonRNIP](http://www.economicdevelopmentbrandon.com/BrandonRNIP) and upload relevant documents such as a resume, cover letter, etc. to the Brandon Rural and Northern Immigration Pilot (RNIP) candidate profile.
- Obtain a qualifying job offer (must be on form IMM5984) from an employer who has been approved to participate in the Brandon RNIP. All jobs posted on the [Brandon RNIP website](#) meet federal and community eligibility criteria and therefore are qualifying jobs.

Jobs can be found in a variety of ways (online, directly through employers, through paid recruiters, etc.), however for a job to meet Brandon's RNIP eligibility criteria the employer and the position offered must have been approved by Economic Development Brandon before a Community Recommendation Application can be submitted and the foreign national must apply for the job through the Brandon RNIP website.

- Submit a Brandon RNIP Community Recommendation [Application](#) and a completed Brandon RNIP Community Recommendation Question document (that will be provided by EDB at the appropriate time) along with supporting documents. All requested supporting and required documents can be uploaded to your Brandon RNIP candidate profile.

Email [immigration@brandon.ca](mailto:immigration@brandon.ca) to let them know when your documents have been uploaded.

### **Brandon RNIP applicant supporting documents**

- Proof of **Education**
- Proof of **Language** Proficiency
- Proof of **work experience** as outlined in your job application
- Applicant's biographical data page of a passport or travel document (includes a photograph and personal information including document expiry date).
- If applicable, proof of **living** in Brandon or the geographic boundaries of the Rural and Northern Immigration Pilot (55 km radius of Brandon) in the past three years
- If applicable, proof of **working** in in Brandon or the geographic boundaries of the Rural and Northern Immigration Pilot (55 km radius of Brandon) in the past three years
- If applicable proof of existing personal connection to Brandon or the geographic boundaries of the Rural and Northern Immigration Pilot (55 km radius of Brandon)

## **Brandon RNIP spouse or common law partner supporting documents (if applicable)**

If applicable, and to be considered for community prioritization criteria points associated with the Brandon RNIP Community Recommendation, the information below is required for the applicant's spouse / common law partner:

- Proof of **Education**
- Proof of **Language** Proficiency
- Proof of current or past **work experience** in Brandon or the geographic boundaries of the Rural and Northern Immigration Pilot (55 km radius of Brandon) in the past three years
- Proof of **living** in Brandon or the geographic boundaries of the Rural and Northern Immigration Pilot (55 km radius of Brandon) in the past three years
- Proof of existing personal connection to Brandon or the geographic boundaries of the Rural and Northern Immigration Pilot (55 km radius of Brandon)

If you receive a Brandon RNIP Community Recommendation submit a RNIP permanent residence application.
