If a foreign national finds a job elsewhere and would like to explore the RNIP program as a possible path to immigration and/or permanent residency, that employer must contact the Economic Development Brandon (EDB) office to ensure the position meets Brandon RNIP job eligibility.

Only apply for jobs that meet your skills, experience and education.

**If an applicant regularly applies for jobs posted on the Brandon RNIP website without the work and education experience, all future job applications submitted through the Brandon RNIP website will not be forwarded to employers.**
