

## **Multi-Family Affordable Housing Program Check List – By-law 6917**

- Is application form **completed** and signed – ensuring that all the supporting documents outlined on page 3 of the application are included.
- Rents that will be charged do not exceed the rents listed below, inclusive of all utilities:

1 bedroom	\$565
2 bedroom	\$675
3 bedroom	\$815
4 + bedroom	\$965
- There are 3 or more apartments in the new building referenced in the Multi-Family Affordable Housing Program, By-Law 6917 application.
- The applicant has confirmed whether the project is eligible for provincial funding administered through the Brandon Neighbourhood Renewal Corporation. If eligible for provincial funding, the applicant must apply for this funding prior to applying for City of Brandon funding under By-law 6917. - **If applicant is eligible for City of Brandon funding only** - the project can be under construction but an occupancy permit must not have been issued at the time of application.
- **If applicant is eligible for city and provincial funding** - the project can not have commenced at the time of application.
- The applicant / property owner must be clear of all City of Brandon taxes and utility charges at the time of application.
